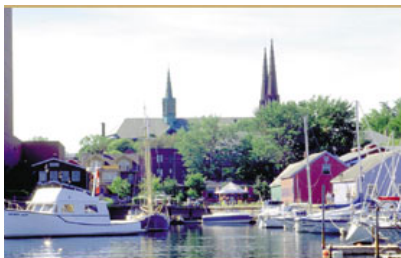
Sea Kayaking - \$115

Anne of Green Gables



Anne of Green Gables was written by Lucy Maud Montgomery in 1908. The book became a hit and Montgomery wrote a series of 8 books around Anne Shirley. The popularity of Anne has extended into many countries with the book being translated into 17 different languages.

Anne of Green Gables was written as fiction for readers of all ages, but in recent decades has been considered a children's book. Montgomery found her inspiration for the book in a newspaper article describing a couple that was mistakenly sent an orphan girl instead of a boy, yet decided to keep her. Montgomery also drew upon her own childhood experiences in rural Prince Edward Island.

Montgomery's influence is felt today in almost every area of life on Prince Edward Island -- in education, research, the arts and theatre communities, tourism, land and building preservation, crafts councils, private businesses, and government policies and decisions. Internationally today Montgomery's works are recognized as touchstones for Canadian culture.
